If you have insurance, file a claim with your insurance company before applying to FEMA. FEMA cannot duplicate insurance payments, but may be able to help where homeowners or flood insurance did not. If you have flood insurance, report your loss immediately to your insurance agent or carrier.



**Please make sure you are carefully documenting all damage in writing and with photographs, receipts and other documentation.**

Residents who need housing assistance should reach out to the **Westchester County Department of Social Services**. If you have a housing emergency, you may call 914-995-2099. If you need immediate assistance, you may also contact the **American Red Cross** at 877-RED-CROSS or **United Way** by dialing **211**.
