Free Medicare Benefits Consultations at New Rochelle Public Library

Senior Benefits Individual Counseling (SBIC), designed to help older adults and those caring for the elderly achieve a better understanding of Medicare health plans and prescription drug coverage, will be available at the New Rochelle Public Library on Thursdays, October 27 and November 10, 2022, 10:00 am - 1:00 pm. Trained counselors, unaffiliated with private insurance companies, are available for drop in appointments to answer questions about Medicare, Medicare Advantage, and Medigap supplement plans; Part D prescription drug coverage; and Medicare savings plans for low-income seniors. Counselors can also assist with questions pertaining to Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP), food stamps and other benefits programs.

SBIC is a program of the Westchester Library System. All consultations are one-on-one and are available on a first-come first-served basis in the 2nd Floor BTOP Conference Room at the Main Library, 1 Library Plaza, New Rochelle.
